

MUSIC EDUCATION – INSTRUMENTS AND VOICE (IGP) - JAZZ

Master's Degree

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS:

(1) The prerequisite for admission to the Master's program is the successful completion of a Bachelor's degree (Baccalaureate) or a study course of equal weight at a recognized national or international postsecondary educational institute, during which the same main artistic subject was studied. Admission to the Master's program depends on an audition in the main artistic subject for all those candidates who did not take the final committee exam for their Bachelor's degree (Baccalaureate) or the 1st Diploma exam of their Diploma study program in Instrumental (Vocal) Pedagogy (IGP) at the University for Music and Performing Arts in Graz. This regulation applies also to those candidates whose final committee exam in their main subject area for the Bachelor's degree (Baccalaureate) or the 1st Diploma exam of their Diploma study program in Instrumental (Vocal) Pedagogy (IGP) at KUG took place more than two semesters ago.

(2) The **completed 1st Diploma exam of the Diploma study program** in Instrumental (Vocal) Pedagogy (IGP) at an Austrian University of the Arts (Music Academy), after the candidate has successfully finished the two Bachelor's papers that are required for that course, will be accepted in place of the Bachelor's exam. Successfully passing the Bachelor's exam is the requirement for admission to the Master's program.

(3) If a **Bachelor's program (Baccalaureat course of study) from a foreign university of the Arts** or comparable post-secondary institute has been recognized by the Dean of Studies as being of equal weight to the Bachelor's program at KUG, and the candidate intends to enter the Master's program, this candidate – if the mother tongue is not German – must, in addition to the entrance audition, prove that his or her competency in German is at the sufficiently high level necessary for the program.
