

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR NON-EU/EWR CITIZENS:

The 2002 Austrian university regulations stipulate that all students from non-EU (European Union) and non-EWR (European Economic Area) countries, as well as students who are stateless, must meet the study admission requirements at KUG and, in addition, meet the immediate right to study at a recognized (accredited) university in the country in which their graduation certificate was issued.

Thus, they must fulfill, in addition to graduating, all the qualifications (for example, entrance exams, interviews, etc.) that are required in the country where they received their graduation certification as a prerequisite for admission into the same program that they have chosen to study at the Kunstuniversität Graz.

This direct admission to university study must be formally confirmed by the Rector/Dean/Registrar of a recognized (accredited) university in the country in which the graduation certificate was issued. It must be clearly stated in this confirmation that they have received the right to begin studying at a recognized (accredited) university in their own country, and that they have the right to begin the study program which they have applied for at the Kunstuniversität Graz without taking further entrance exams, interviews, etc., in the academic year in which they wish to be accepted at KUG.

Applicants who do not have confirmation that they have mastered the German language, that is, having proof in the form of an Austrian language diploma (ÖSD Sprachdiplom Oberstufe Deutsch C1), Goethe certificate C1, Test-DaF TDN 5, or the German language exam for college entrance level 2/DSH-2 and level 3 – DSH-4, must take an additional exam in German before the start of their regular studies.
