

Brief Information about the Consultation Meeting

(Presentation of the intended Doctoral study plan)

at the time of admission to the Dr. artium Program at KUG

Over the whole period of study, every doctoral candidate will be assigned a doctoral committee consisting of one artistic and one scholarly (academic) adviser from KUG as well as one external artistic and one external scholarly (academic) adviser. In the course of the presentation, the research intentions are to be discussed with the doctoral committee.¹ Discussion is based on the materials submitted, in particular the Exposé, as well as on a possible artistic presentation.

In order to present as clear a picture as possible, the

Exposé

should contain the following items:

- presentation of the intended Artistic Research Topic
- the current state of research (with reference to any important publications that may have already appeared on the topic)
- indication of the planned course of action: methodology to be used, the sequence of work stages necessary, financial requirements, etc.
- the candidate's personal prior qualifications for the successful completion of the chosen topic (e.g. artistic and/or scholarly projects, other kinds of prior knowledge, etc.)
